Fire Assembly Point Guidelines

To ensure the safety of all personnel during an evacuation, please adhere to the following:

- **Location Strategy:** Our designated assembly point is located at **Opposite the Path4 Entrance on the far end wall**. This location has been chosen because it is clear of the building's "collapse zone" and does not hinder emergency vehicle access.
- **The "Sweep" and Roll Call:** Upon arrival at the assembly point, Fire Wardens from each business must conduct a roll call using the daily visitor log and staff manifest.
- **Cross-Business Reporting:** Once a roll call is complete, the Lead Fire Warden from each business should signal to their neighbouring counterparts (or the Site Manager) that their unit is "Clear" or report if anyone is missing.
- **Accessibility:** Ensure your assembly point is accessible for all employees, including those with limited mobility. If a Personal Emergency Evacuation Plan (PEEP) requires a specific refuge or assembly area, ensure it is clearly marked.

- **Weather and Safety:** In the event of extreme weather or a long-duration incident, the secondary assembly point is located at **[Insert Secondary Location, e.g., The Community Centre across the road]**.

Maintenance of Assembly Points

- **Signage:** Assembly points must be clearly marked with the standard green and white "Fire Assembly Point" signage.
