Physical Access:

- To address this, we will repurpose ground-floor rooms for learning activities and provide one-to-one support.

Sensory Impairments:

- o Students with visual impairments may struggle with traditional print materials.
- To accommodate these needs, we will provide large-print materials and audio books.
- o Students with dyslexia can benefit from materials printed on coloured paper.

2. Physical Environment

Mobility Impairments:

 The school's physical environment presents challenges for wheelchair users and individuals with mobility aids.
